E/W easily bid to 4♠ but we pushed on to 5♣ which wasn't doubled (I have no idea why not!).

On the face of it E/W should be able to make 11 tricks but the problem is that E cannot ever get over to make diamond tricks in W and therefore can make 10 tricks only. This is what happened at the other table where our partners were left to play in 4♠ – we can only make 7 tricks ie 4 off. It would have been a very different story if we had been doubled where it would have been -800 instead of -200. This board made for a reasonably respectable score for the round even though we were beaten.

All in all a very good weekend.
