A thank you note from the President




In the end, after eight 14 board matches, two teams singled themselves out for a dash to the finishing line with the Sunderasan team being a little too strong for the Johnson team.

One board that had a bearing on the result of match 5 between the two teams was hand 9.


Unfortunately, the Johnson team found a way to make sacrificebids at both tables.
