IMP scoring - ENTER AS A PAIR

Qualification to the Open ITS Final is via one of the following tournaments.

2 pairs from Stage I of the Open ITS will qualify directly to the Open Final.

4 pairs from Stage I of the Open ITS can qualify directly to Women's Final.

10 pairs will qualify from Stage II of the Open ITS.

2 pairs will qualify from the Open Last Train Event.

The top three pairs in the Final will represent NSW at the Australian National Championships in Hobart 18 – 23 July (subject to Council ratification).

Red Masterpoints will be awarded at State Championship level.

- All entrants should be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Except in cases of emergency all substitutions must be ratified **in advance** by the NSWBA Tournament Committee.
- Prior entry is required. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- Yellow systems permitted in Stage II and the Final only. Pairs wishing to play a Yellow system must submit a copy of the system and a suggested defence for the opponents to the Chairman of the Tournament Committee 1 week before the start of the event.
- ANC representatives should make every effort to be available to play in the Teams of Three Congress (Sunday 6th June).
- All results, including datums, will be posted on the web.
