Enter as a team of 4, 5 or 6.

All team members must play at least 50% of the total number of boards.

Entry Fee: \$288 per team (GST incl.)

*The winning team will represent NSW as the Seniors Team at the
Australian National Championships in Darwin 8th – 13th July
(subject to Council ratification).*

If a team of 4 or 5 qualifies it may be allowed to augment to a team of 6.

- All entrants should be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Non-contending teams may enter.
- Except in cases of emergency all substitutions must be ratified **in advance** by the NSWBA Tournament Committee.
- Prior entry is required. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- All systems will be permitted. Pairs wishing to play a Yellow system must submit a copy of the system and a suggested defence for the opponents to the Chairman of the Tournament Committee before Saturday 28th April.
- ANC representatives should make every effort to be available to play in the Teams of Three Congress (Sunday 3rd June).
- Players must live over 100 km from the NSWBA to be eligible for the country player subsidy.
- All results, including datums, will be posted on the web.
