

HOW TO GET THERE

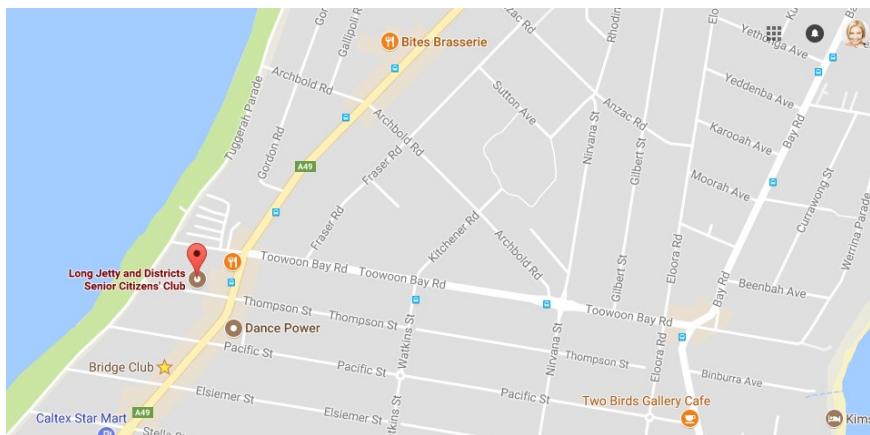
From the South

Travel the M1 and follow exit signs to Wyong /The Entrance. Travel along Wyong Road until you come to the roundabout at The Central Coast Highway. Take the first exit (turn left) towards The Entrance. You will see our clubhouse on your left. You may either take a left at the set of traffic lights at Thompson Street and park there or go one street beyond at Toowoon Bay Road for much more parking.

From the North

If travelling the M1 follow exit signs to Wyong/The Entrance and follow directions above. If coming through The Entrance turn right onto Toowoon Bay Road or turn at the next set of traffic lights at Thompson Street and find parking.

Please do not park in the Long Jetty Hotel carpark on Thompson Street.
