2019 SENIORS' INTERSTATE TEAM SELECTION

will be played in 2 stages on

Friday 17th, Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th May

ENTER AS A PAIR

All players must be born before 1st January 1959.

This event is restricted to contending senior pairs, *i.e.* all entrants declare their availability to represent NSW at the Melbourne ANC.

The Qualification Stage: Friday 17th April at 10.00am

Entry Fee: \$45 per player (GST incl.)

Two sessions using IMP scoring, qualifying up to 14 pairs to the Final.

The Final: Saturday 18th & Sunday 19th April at 10.00am

Entry Fee: \$90 per player (GST incl.)

Four sessions using Butler IMP scoring.

The number of pairs that qualify to the Final and the formats for both stages are dependent on the size of the initial entry. See the Supplementary Regulations for details.

Subject to Council ratification, the top three pairs will represent NSW as the Seniors' Team at the Australian National Championships in Melbourne from 14th - 18th July.

Red Masterpoints at State Championship level will be awarded.

Country players who play in this event may apply for a country player subsidy.

- All entrants must be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Prior entry is required. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- All substitutions must be requested **in advance** by submitting the online form at www.nswba.com.au/forms/substitute.asp. See the Supplementary Regulations for the number of substitutions allowed.
- Yellow systems are permitted in the Final only. Pairs wishing to play a Yellow system must submit a copy of the system and a suggested defence for the opponents to the Chairman of the Tournament Committee before 11th May.
- ANC representatives are required to play in the Teams of Three Congress (Sunday 2nd June).
- Players must live over 100 km from the NSWBA to be eligible for the country player subsidy.
