Entries are limited to players with a home club in NSW or ACT. Entries close Friday September 25<sup>th</sup> at 5pm – latecomers and exceptions at directors discretion.

On the day each participant must enter on BBO with their partner from 7:30am (two hours prior to start of play) and must be online in the competition area at 9:25am (five minutes before start of play). You will only be able to enter in the section for which you have signed-up.

Prizes are BB\$/pair, rounded down to whole \$ transferred to the winners BBO accounts. They are awarded to the top ¼ of the field similar to the awarding of Red masterpoints.

There will need to be 16 tables for the Congress to proceed. If there are at least 12 tables in both Open and Restricted, there will be two separate sections. The convener reserves the right to modify prize monies accordingly.

Conducted under the auspices of the NSWBA. The ABF has approved the issue of Red Master Points at B4 level. No yellow systems allowed.

All players are subject to the NSWBA's Congress Disciplinary Regulations and Rules for Online Congresses. Partnerships are encouraged to have a system card that includes the real names of the players. Pairs without a system card may find themselves at a disadvantage in respect to misinformation rulings.
