Programme of Events

Play commences at 10.00am sharp on Wednesday 26th January 2022 for two sessions: three 8-board matches; a break for lunch; then another three 8-board matches. Entry in advance on NSWBA website required.

Venue opens at 9am. We maintain **NO JAB NO ENTRY** policy. All our staff are fully vaccinated. You MUST show your vaccination certificate upon entry. please arrive at least 15 minutes before the start time to allow for vaccination certificate check and other possible CovidSafe procedures. Individual snack pack on arrival and individual packed lunch will be served to your table. Please have your certificate ready when enter the venue.

We can only accommodate a maximum of 112 players at any one time. We intend to have two separate fields – Open and Novice & Restricted*, depending on the table numbers. Please nominate the field you would like to compete in on the NSWBA website, or you will be placed in the category based on the masterpoints ranking of the pair as at 1st December 2021.

*Novice & Restricted player will have fewer than 300 masterpoints as at 1st December 2021.

CovidSafe Guideline & Etiquette

Our Covid safety measures also include bigger tabletops, spaced out tables, limited seating, individual snack bag upon arrival and individual packed meals to serve at the table, etc. Please arrive 15-20 minutes before the game start for the CovidSafe procedure.

There will be some inconvenience under the Covid restrictions. We appreciate your understanding and we sincerely ask you to be kind and considerate to our staff, directors and the other players.

We have zero tolerance to bad behaviour in any circumstances.
