

HOW TO GET THERE

Public Transport

Consult the Sydney/Central Station to Newcastle Interchange Rail Timetable, for trains which will stop at the Tuggerah Station before 9.00am. Contact the convenor (0417 453 170) prior to **15th March** to discuss pick up options from the station based on your arrival time.

Motor Vehicle from the South

Travel the M1 and follow exit signs to Wyong | The Entrance. Travel along Wyong Road until you come to the roundabout at The Central Coast Highway. Use the turn left lane towards The Entrance. Turn left at Thompson Street. Parking is on Street.

Motor Vehicle from the North

If travelling the M1 follow exit signs to Wyong/The Entrance and follow directions above. If coming through The Entrance turn right onto Thompson Street.
