Kiama is 90 minutes drive from Sydney CBD (31 Shoalhaven St, Kiama). **The Sebel Harbourside has a lovely setting overlooking the water.** The function centre is heritage listed and was the Kiama Infants School for over 100 years!



Attractions around the area:

- Whale & dolphin watching
- Kiama Coastal walk (there are different sections easily accessible from Kiama)
- Minnamurra Rainforest (15 mins drive) – walk to the falls or rainforest loop
- Kiama blowhole & Little Blowhole; ocean pools, Saddleback Mountain lookout (10 mins drive); photogenic Cathedral Rocks (Jones Beach in Kiama Downs); “The Boneyard” cove & Bombo Headland.
- Wednesday afternoon farmers’ market; historic Terrace Houses & shops; Old Fire Station Community Arts Centre exhibitions
- Kiama golf course; Grand Pacific Drive - the scenic road all the way to Kiama

Start your holiday on **Tuesday** from 1pm with a talk and then a duplicate session from 2pm. Dinner is in The Quarry Room overlooking the water at the venue.
