What so special about Teams?

It is great fun playing TEAMS in bridge!

Most experienced players rate teams competition highly and many prefer Teams to Duplicate Pairs. Because of the differences in scoring, different tactics are appropriate.

In the regular club pairs sessions, your score is compared to all other pairs holding the same cards. The key to success is how often you are ahead of your opponents (the other pairs sitting in your direction). In teams, you have only one opponent. He or she is sitting in your seat at your current opposition's home table. The key to winning is how much you do better than your opponents on each board. Enter now to explore the Teams format!

Programmes

Play commences at 10.00am sharp on Monday 1st April for two sessions: three 8-board matches in the morning, break for lunch, then another three 8-boards matches in the afternoon. Please form a team with 4 players. <u>Entry in advance</u> on NSWBA website required.

We plan to have separate field for Novice & Restricted teams. Prize money will depend on the number of entries.
