Range is nominally $7-11$ however suits headed AJT or KQ can open with nothing outside. 2 M is typically opened with reasonable 5 card suits but may include poor 6 card suits headed by $K$ or $Q$ and $7-8$ points. 2 is opened with reasonable 6 card suits $7-11$ or poor 6 card suits headed by $K$ or $Q$ and $9-11$ points. We have not opened 7 card preempts at the 2 level in the past. 3rd in hand is much more wide ranging.
