## 2020 SENIORS' INTERSTATE TEAM SELECTION

will be played in 1 or 2 stages on

Friday 15<sup>th</sup>, Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May

### ENTER AS A PAIR

**All players must be born before 1<sup>st</sup> January 1960.**

**This event is restricted to contending senior pairs, *i.e.* all entrants declare their availability to represent NSW at the Adelaide ANC.**

\*The Qualification Stage: Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May at 10.00am  
Entry Fee: \$45 per player (GST incl.)

Two sessions using IMP scoring, qualifying up to 14 pairs to the Final.

\*The Final: Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May at 10.00am  
Entry Fee: \$90 per player (GST incl.)

Four sessions using Butler IMP scoring.

\*If 18 or fewer pairs enter, a single stage event (entry fee \$135) will be played over the 3 scheduled days.

***Subject to Council ratification, the top three pairs will represent NSW as the Seniors' Team at the Australian National Championships in Adelaide from 12<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> July.***

**Red Masterpoints at State Championship level will be awarded.**

Country players who play in this event may apply for a country player subsidy.

- All entrants must be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Prior entry is required. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- All substitutions must be requested **in advance** by submitting the online form at [www.nswba.com.au/forms/substitute.asp](http://www.nswba.com.au/forms/substitute.asp). See the Supplementary Regulations for the number of substitutions allowed.
- Yellow systems are permitted in the Final only. Pairs wishing to play a Yellow system must submit a copy of the system and a suggested defence for the opponents to the Chairman of the Tournament Committee before 8<sup>th</sup> May.
- ANC representatives are expected to play in the Teams of Three Congress (Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May).
- Players must live over 100 km from the NSWBA to be eligible for the country player subsidy.
