2021 SENIORS' INTERSTATE TEAM SELECTION

will be played in 1 or 2 stages on

Friday 14th, Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th May

ENTER AS A PAIR

All sessions are to be played at the NSWBA. If Covid-19 restrictions prevent free movement of players, the event will be played online using the RealBridge platform over four sessions on Wednesday nights (5, 12, 19 & 26 May) beginning at 7.15 pm with entry fee of \$50 per person.

All players must be born before 1st January 1960.

This event is restricted to contending senior pairs, *i.e.* all entrants declare their availability to represent NSW at the Perth ANC.

*The Qualification Stage: Friday 14th May at 10.00am

Entry Fee: \$45 per player (GST incl.)

Two sessions using IMP scoring, qualifying up to 14 pairs to the Final.

*The Final: Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th May at 10.00am

Entry Fee: \$90 per player (GST incl.)

Four sessions using [Cross IMP scoring](#).

*If 18 or fewer pairs enter, a single stage event (entry fee \$135) will be played over the 3 scheduled days.

Subject to Council ratification, the top three pairs will represent NSW as the Seniors' Team at the Australian National Championships in Perth from 12th - 16th July.

Red Masterpoints at State Championship level will be awarded.

Country players who play in this event may apply for a country player subsidy.

- All entrants must be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Prior entry is required. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- All substitutions must be requested **in advance** by submitting the online form at www.nswba.com.au/forms/substitute.asp. See the Supplementary Regulations for the number of substitutions allowed.
- Yellow systems are permitted in the Final only. Pairs wishing to play a Yellow system must submit a copy of the system and a suggested defence for the opponents to the Chairman of the Events Committee before 7th May.
- ANC representatives are expected to play in the Teams of Three Congress (Sunday 6th June).
- Players living over 100 km from the NSWBA are eligible for a country player subsidy.
