## Programme of Events

Play commences at 10.00am sharp on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2021 for two sessions: three 9-board matches; a break for lunch; then another three 9-board matches. Entry in advance on NSWBA website required.

Venue opens at 9am. Please arrive at least 15 minutes before the start time to allow for CovidSafe procedures (temperature check, hand sanitising and contact tracing sign in). Individual snack pack on arrival and individual packed lunch will be served to your table. Please familiarise yourself with our CovidSafe Guideline before entering the venue.

We can only accommodate a maximum of 100 players at any one time. We intend to have two separate fields – Open and Novice & Restricted\*, depending on the table numbers. Please nominate the field you would like to compete in on the NSWBA website, or you will be placed in the category based on the masterpoints ranking of the pair as at 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020.

*\*Novice & Restricted player will have fewer than 300 masterpoints as at 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020.*

## CovidSafe Guideline & Etiquette

There will be some inconvenience under the Covid restrictions. We appreciate your understanding and we sincerely ask you to be kind and considerate to our staff, directors and the other players.

We have zero tolerance to bad behaviour in any circumstances.
